Online Course Fee

Textbooks													
Students are responsible for purchasing textbooks and supplies required for class. Although the cost of textbooks and supplies varies according to the program, the average per 15 credit hours is \$294. The cost of textbooks is not included in the Total Program Cost figures above.													
Housing (Optional)													
Accommodations are provided on a Quarterly basis for those who require housing. The shared housing fee is \$2,350 and private housing fee is \$4,000 per quarter. A one time, non-refundable security fee of \$200 is required and charged to the first Quarter's invoice. The cost of housing is not included in the Total Program Cost figures above.													
Study Trip (Optional)													
Study Trips to various parts of the world are scheduled annually for students in specific programs. The fee, which varies, covers round trip transportation and hotel accommodation. Students are responsible for their meals and incidentals. Students may earn academic credit upon satisfactory completion of the requirements set by the instructor. The cost of Study Trips is not included in the Total Program Cost figures above.													
STRF Fee													
The University is required to access State of California Student Recovery Fund (STRF) Fees against all California resident students. The STRF Fee is currently .25% of the tuition assessed on a per Quarter basis. STRF Fees are not included in the Total Program Cost figures above.
